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Police Clearance Service Center is the police agency authorized to issue Police Clearance Certificate for application who needs to travel abroad for the purpose of education, marriage, occupation or migration.

Procedures of Certifying fingerprint for Thai Police Clearance

1. Have your fingerprint done at the Police Station nearest to you.
2. Have your fingerprint Certify at the local Office of Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. Royal Thai Embassy only Certify Signature of the Officer from Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
3. Copy of Your Passport.
4. The Fee is \$25 (Money Order, Bank Cheque **pay to Royal Thai Embassy**) for each Signature of the officer from Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
5. Enclose Registered Post Envelope or Express Post Envelope with your address written on it. We will send the documents back to you when it is done.
6. Send all of the above documents to the Royal Thai Embassy in Canberra or Royal Thai Consulate General in Sydney for Certifying Signature of the Officer of Department Of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
