2. Job Description and Responsibilities

2.1 Operate the Embassy's vehicle as instructed, including transport of passengers and packages from one location to another as assigned;

- 2.2 Carry out vehicle maintenance checks, including engine oil and cooling system, electric and break systems, tires, battery, air conditioning and petrol, to ensure that the vehicle is in good condition, safe, clean and ready to use;
 - 2.3 Perform duty as assigned;
 - 2.4 Strictly comply with relevant local traffic laws and regulations;
 - 2.5 Perform other functions as assigned by the Embassy.

3. Qualifications

- 3.1 Must be an Australian citizen or a Permanent Resident in Australia;
- 3.2 Possess a valid Australian driver's licence of no less than five years and have driving experience of no less than five years;
 - 3.3 Have good knowledge of Australian traffic laws and regulations;
- 3.4 Does not have health condition that may affect the performance of duty, e.g. high blood pressure, colour blind, cardiac disease, or other disease that may be not be suitable for driving. Medical certificate will be required;
- 3.5 Have good knowledge of roads and directions in ACT and nearby areas, including New South Wales;
- 3.6 Have basic knowledge on mechanics, car maintenance and able to drive vehicle(s) with automatic and manual transmission;
- 3.7 Does not consume alcohol over the legal limit and does not obsess with gambling or involve in drugs;
- 3.8 Never been bankrupt or imprisoned or charged with serious traffic violation, unless for petty offences;
- 3.9 Possess a positive and professional attitude, be a responsible person with good interpersonal skill, able to provide reliable, efficient and courteous service to the supervisor and others and able to maintain cordial relations with colleagues;

- 3.10 Senior high school education or higher with good command in English language; and
- 3.11 Able to work overtime and during weekends and holidays, as may be assigned occasionally.
