

Checklist of required documents for Thai and non-Thai nationals seeking permission to enter Thailand

***Please note that all non-Thai nationals must obtain medical insurance or letter from employer guaranteeing that the insurance company or employer will cover a minimum of 100,000 USD (or equivalent in other currencies) of medical costs incurred by the applicant in Thailand, including medical costs in the event that applicant contracts COVID-19. (The insurance must cover the total duration of stay in Thailand.)**

1 APEC card holder, holding an APEC card embedded “THA” code in the back of the card, must travel from 10 countries/ territories (Australia, China, Hong Kong, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan or Vietnam), and is permitted to stay in Thailand for 90 days.

2 The applicant must be a foreigner age of 50 and over who have a permanent residence in a country in which the application is submitted.

Holder of Non-Immigrant O-A visa is allowed to stay in Thailand for 1 year. Employment of any kind is strictly prohibited.

3 The applicant must be an ordinary passport holder with a nationality of Japan, Australia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, Canada, and the United States of America, with the age of 50 years old and over, including spouse and child (age under 20 years old). Holder of Non-Immigrant O-X visa is allowed to stay in Thailand for 5 years each time (total 10 years). Employment of any kind is strictly prohibited.

4 Passport holder of countries and territories entitled for visa exemption (Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme and Bilateral Agreement). The list is attached for further information.

5 Tourist Visa (TR) holder is permitted to stay in Thailand for 60 days and can apply for a 30-day extension.

6 A non-Immigrant B visa holder is permitted to stay in Thailand for 90 days. Applicant must have an invitation letter from a Thai company with a registered capital not less than 2 million THB or evidence showing ownership of a condominium/ deposit in a Thai bank/ Thai government bond with face value not less than 3 million THB.

7 STV visa holder is allowed to stay in Thailand for 90 days and the STV can be extended 2 times, 90 days each.
